## **Rules of Entry**

- 1. There is no limit to the number of relevant categories a company or organisation can enter, but a separate entry form must be submitted for each category.
- 2. All entries will be treated in the strictest confidence and will only be used for the purpose of this judging process. Your contact details will not be passed to 3rd parties.
- 3. The independent judging panel, consisting of experts from the Information Security Industry, will mark each entry against specific criteria.
- 4. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into after the final decision has been made.
- 5. Sponsors and their companies cannot enter the category they are sponsoring.
- 6. Once an individual, company, or organisation is announced as a finalist, the company cannot withdraw from the competition.
- 7. Shortlisted candidates will be informed no later than four weeks before the awards event and invited to attend the Awards on the night of Tuesday 15th November 2016 at Te Papa.
- 8. Winners and finalists may inform of their status in advertising, or use the position-specific logo for promotional and marketing purposes, but it must be clear in which category and year they were successful.
- 9. The winners will be revealed and presented with their awards at the Awards Ceremony on Tuesday 15th November 2016 at Te Papa.
- 10. All entries and nominations close at noon on 26 September 2016.

## **Submission of entries**

Your entry form should have:

- 1. Category selection;
- 2. Case brief (clearly articulating how the criteria of the category has been met in a maximum 1000 words); and
- 3. Supporting materials. (optional maximum size 2MB)
